

# HALIFAX SHOPPING CENTRE – MALL RULES

To ensure a safe and pleasant environment, Halifax Shopping Centre management asks that you comply with the rules of conduct listed below. Violation of the shopping centre rules will result in the issuance of a Protection of Property Notice to the shopping centre property and/or Provincial fines. Please direct any comments or questions to Halifax Shopping Centre Security Department at 497.9276. Thank you for your anticipated cooperation.

## **The following activities are prohibited on Halifax Shopping Centre property:**

1. Smoking inside the shopping centre or in non-designated areas.
2. Loitering anywhere on the property. This also includes sitting in the Food Court for extended periods of time without food or drink.
3. Any behaviour that may interfere with the enjoyment of the facilities for other patrons and tenants. This includes running, horseplay, fighting, using profanities, playing of radios or CD players etc.
4. Wearing of disguises (ie, masks, balaclavas, face warmers, hoods, bandanas, etc.) in the shopping centre.
5. Distribution of flyers or other literature, or solicitation of products or services, without written permission from mall management.
6. Congregating in large groups so as to interfere with mall traffic.
7. Using mall property such as tables, chairs, trash containers, etc. for other than their intended use.
8. Possession of weapons (real or toy) at any time. Purchase of these items must be kept in the original packaging while on our property and must accompany a sales receipt of the date of purchase.
9. Taking photographs or videotaping on the property without prior permission from management.
10. Being in restricted areas of the mall (i.e. back corridors, designated parking stalls, barricaded areas after mall hours) without prior permission from mall management.
11. Any infraction to public health and safety regulations, including no smoking in the building, no pets (excluding special aid pets) in the common areas. Animals are not permitted to be tied and/or left unattended on mall property. Also, shirts and shoes must be worn in the mall.
12. Rollerblading and skateboarding anywhere on the property.
13. Bringing a bicycle inside the shopping centre.

Customer cooperation is required in safely using mall equipment and elevating devices.
